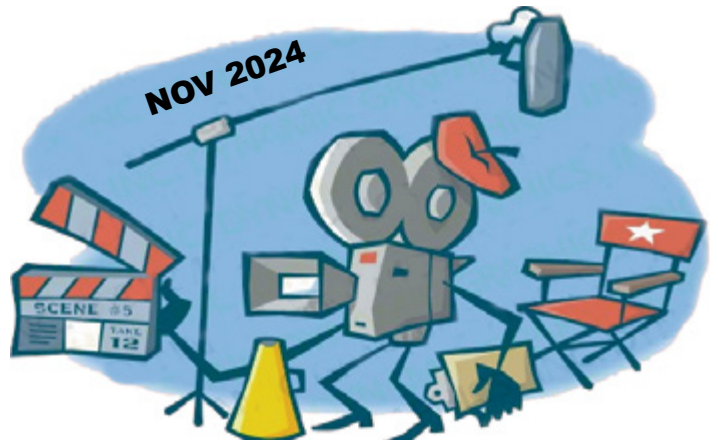

Cathy won the 50/50 draw for the third time... in a roll...wth?



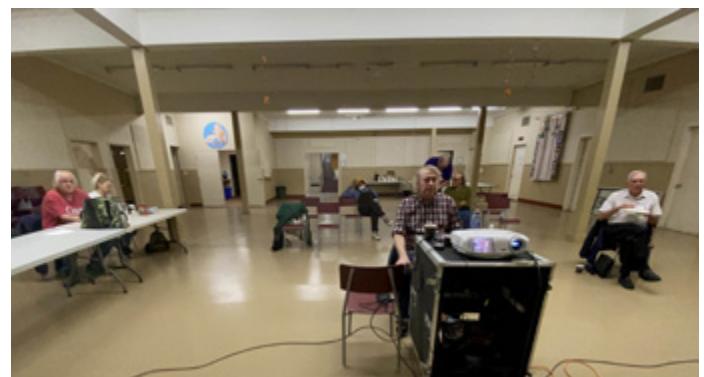
